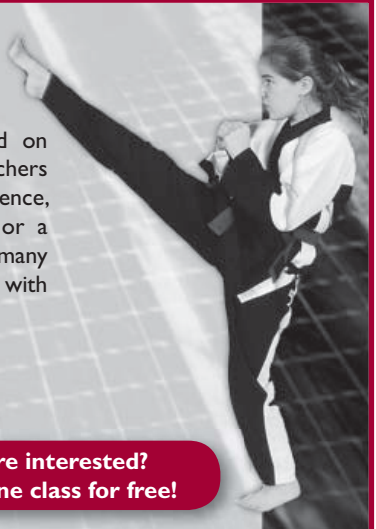
Family Martial Arts

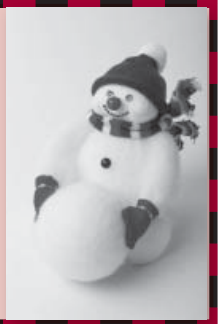

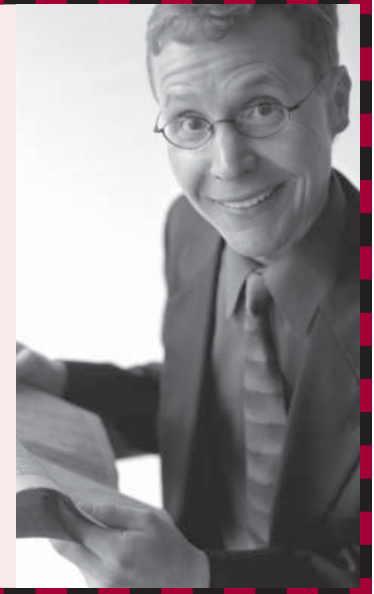
